



Application

This portion of the module is to be accomplished outside of class.

In your unit you may be teaching your students about the parts of a flower or the parts of a sentence, the gears in a machine, political or geographical maps, the differences between maple leaves and oak leaves, the meaning of fractions. Sequencing procedural information is an important area where students can use the “drag and drop” facility of the drawing environment. For this activity, create a diagram supporting your unit which students can label on the computer by using “drag and drop”.

The activity described above **must**:

- ◆ **Include** appropriate but limited text in:
 - ◆ 2 different fonts and 2 different sizes for.
 - ◇ Directions explaining what the student is to accomplish.
 - ◇ Student’s name.
 - ◆ at least 2 of the following:enhancements
 - ◇ Bold, Italics, Underline, Double Underline.
 - ◆ at least 2 colors. **DO NOT** use black.
 - ◆ a heading or title using “graphical” or “paint pick-up” followed by “for Mr./Ms._____’s class”.

ALSO include:

- ◆ 3 different geometric shapes (drawing tools) in 3 of the following:
 - ◇ color, texture, pattern, or gradient.
- ◆ 3 line widths using a combination of both color and/or pattern.
- ◆ clippings (from AppleWorks).
- ◆ Your digital photograph.
- ◆ Elimination of the drawing grid
- ◆ Name file **DIAGRAM.CWK**.

Use your unit to create a sample concept map, idea map, or web. This visual learning should include:

- ◇ Main idea
- ◇ At least, 4 subtopics
- ◇ 4-6 additional topics as they apply to those subtopic
- ◇ Graphics
- ◇ Relationship descriptions where applicable
- ◇ Save as an Inspiration file (.ins) and export the page as a web page.
- ◇ Fonts in different sizes, colors, and types.
- ◇ Color sub-subtopics to group under a given topic
