### **Extension 1 - Expand Your Stack**

1. Add at least four (4) of the following to your HyperStudio stack (**must** be marked on criteria sheet):
  - Animation
  - Effects (Cookie Cutter, Gradient).
  - Other NBA (HideShow, BlabberMouth, GhostWriter, SlideShow, etc.).
  - Your picture using a cameo.
  - Original sound (human voice, special music, music movie, etc.).
  - Quicktime Movies (cut down to a portion of the original).
  - Scanned picture (from books, magazines, photographs, etc.).
  - Use Testing Functions (found under Things To Do) and have names and results in HS.Test.Results.
  - Special graphic objects (Group items, Draggable, etc.).
  - Running another program (such as Netscape).
2. If you use either of the following they will count as their extension in another module and part of this extension.
  - Original sound (music movie).
  - Quicktime Movies (cut down to a portion of the original).

### **Extension 2 - Create a Travel Journal Stack (language majors)**

This trip could be a real trip or an imaginary one. A travel journal is usually thought to be a handwritten record of one's experiences. In this project the travel journal will take the role of a multimedia tour guide. Create an interactive (Menu-driven) travel journal with highlights of each stop along the trip. Have a map, route, method of transportation, etc. Include sounds, movies, pictures, and a little text to tie it together. The stack should have a minimum of 4 cards, sounds, transitions, graphics, and web sites appropriate to the trip. All buttons should be in a text format.

### **Extension 3 - Create a Family History Stack**

Family history is something that should be cherished and passed down through generations. Create an interactive stack of your family tree (you may have done family tree in the DP module. Tell the story of family member based on things that happened during their life. In this stack, find web pages of things that happened during the life of various family member (WW2, President Kennedy's death, sinking of the Titanic, etc.) and link them to the page about that family member.
