## Extension 1 - Newsletter for Unit

Create a sample 2 page newsletter supporting your unit. This will be similar to the newsletter created in your Guided Practice but containing your unit information. As well as satisfying the basic format (2 pages, masthead or banner, minimum of two columns, “wrapped” graphics, justified margins, etc.), please include:

- ◊ A **MINIMUM** of one article split between two pages. Indicated appropriate continuation information.
- ◊ Incorporate a scanned picture.
- ◊ Use one of the special text methods (Graphical, Paint Pick-up, Shadow).
- ◊ Place the Masthead (banner) in a shadow box.
- ◊ Save as **NEWSE.CWK**

## Extension 2 - Presentation

Read the information in the Microteaching module before starting this extension. Consider that this may be an interesting method of introducing (set Induction) your microteaching..

1. This presentation is to present your unit topic.
2. It should consist of:
  - ◆ A **MINIMUM** of 6 slides:
    - ◊ Title slide containing the subject, presenter, and date code.
    - ◊ The opening slide states the main points of the presentation in phrases.:
    - ◆ The remaining slides detail the main points
      - ◊ Use phrases that start with an action verb.
      - ◊ Any phrase that extends into two lines on a slide should be edited (shortened).
      - ◊ Use the 6 X6 rule (no more than 6 lines of text per slide - no more than 6 words per line).
      - ◊ Space text evenly.
    - ◊ The closing slides contains a review of the main points or restates important points.
    - ◆ A last slide containing one of the following terms:
      - ◊ “Questions”/”Discussion”/”Comments” etc.
      - ◊ Use one of the Backgrounds found in “**Starting Point - Templates**”
    - ◊ Consistent headings for each slide.
    - ◊ A **Minimum** of 2 different fonts and 2 different points.
    - ◊ Bullets or other symbols to organize lists (choose **ONE**).
    - ◊ A **MINIMUM** of 9 different graphics or clip art (including charts).
    - ◊ Select transitions that group the material.
    - ◊ Spell check all screens.
  - 3. The presentation must be done in color including background, text, and graphics.
  - 4. Your presentation should be professional and polished.
  - 5. Save the file as **PRESENT1E.CWK**.
  - 6. The presentation should be accompanied by a “speaker notes” detailing your talk. Use the **OUTLINE** feature of **AppleWorks** to create this material.

**NOTE 1:** Be sure the text on each slide is succinct, using action verbs and phrases for each point you are making.

### Extension 2:

- ◇ Make the 2nd slide a menu where each item when clicked will take you to an appropriate slide. Put a button on each slide to take you back to the menu. (see Dr Burson for help)
- ◇ Incorporate "Word Art".
- ◆ Include at least 3 of the following:
  - ◇ A movie supporting your presentation/unit .
  - ◇ Sound supporting your presentation/unit (Use a movie without pictures).
  - ◇ A scanned photograph or picture supporting your presentation/unit.
  - ◇ A edited digitized photograph (this may be the scanned photograph mentioned above)
- ◇ Save this presentation as **PRESENT1EE.CWK**.
- ◇ Be sure to save movies and/or sound files in your **Extension** folder.

### ◇ **Extension 4 - Web Page 1 - School**

- ◇ Many schools currently have their own web pages and teachers are asked to participate. Determine a school and grade level of your choosing (real or imaginary) and design your web page using **Netscape Composer**. Use the following link for ideas:
  - ◇ <http://web66.coled.umn.edu/schools.html>
- ◇ This Web page should contain a minimum of 3 links to pages on the Web. Use graphics appropriate to your grade level to decorate the page (another group from Vikimouse perhaps). The web page should contain a graphic background or background color and text in at least 2 different sizes and a color other than black. Save the page as **WEB1E.CWK**.
- ◇ **NOTE: This may be a good start for a web page for your cooperating teacher.**

### ◇ **Extension 5 - Web Page 2 - States**

Look at the "Local City/County/State Information" on the following Web page

Choose one of your states from the States Research exercise (Module 4) and create a Web page using **Netscape Composer** and the bookmarks used in that activity. This Web page should contain a minimum of 5 links to pages on the Web. Use graphics appropriate to the State to decorate the page. The web page should contain a graphic background or background color and text in at least 2 different sizes and a color other than black. Save the page as **WEB2E.CWK**.

### ◇ **Extension 6 - Web Page 3 - AppleWorks**

- ◇ Produce a web page lesson using **AppleWorks** by searching for "web page" in **Help**. Use the Zooish site at <http://www.zooish.com/> plus at least two relate links. Find textbook data to scan and include in the site. Place the folder you created in your **IndependentE** folder.

### ◇ **Extension 7 - Web Page 4-Seating Chart**

- ◇ If you have already submitted the **Seating Chart** extension from Draw/Paint , use **Netscape Composer** and the graphic, **SEAT** as the primary graphic on the Web page for this extension. Add a title and appropriate text to the Web page to explain the graphic, **SEAT**. Add an animate .GIF appropriate to the page. Save the page as **SEAT\_CHART.HTML**.

### ◇ **Extension 8 - TrackStar**

- ◇ This is a companion to the extension in the Teach net module, however, it is not required that the first one be done to do this one. Use the URLs in your bookmark list to create a Track. Use the **URL** (<http://www.hprtec.org/>) to review the tutorial for creating a track. Create an appropriate lesson. Use at least 4 URLs. When you have created the track send the **URL** to **Class**.
